

BALAD_E: Balad is an ancient Arabic word; it refers to a town, city or country but also to the process of civilization. An E is added to the word BALAD, it forms the French word "Balade" witch means a stroll. BALAD_E is a stroll into the "no carbon" world, in a joyful way, through the past and the future.

ne year after its major actions and exhibitions during COP21 (the 21st United nations conference on climate change, Paris, Dec 2015), the French association Art of Change 21 presents BALAD_E in partnership with the Foundation Schneider Electric and UN Environment: a one-of-a-kind event for COP22 in Marrakech, Morocco, from November 7th to 18th, 2016.

For **COP22**, in a leading country in solar energy and art, with the Marrakesh Biennale of Contemporary Art, Art of Change 21 joins forces with the renowned artist and "upcycler" **Hassan Hajjaj** to create an original program linking the fields of culture, sustainable development and innovation.

November 10th - 17th, 2016

Art of Change 21 will offer daily talks, debates, workshops, concerts, art performances, the Paleo-Energetic Fresco, exhibitions, festive moments and a press conference in the **Riad Yima** of Hassan Hajjaj, in the heart of the Medina.

Themed bicycle tours through Marrakech will be organized twice a day in partnership with **Pikala Bikes** and the **CMEM** (Centre Méditerranéen de l'Environnement de Marrakech). They will allow participants to discover, with special guides, the most unique sustainable locations of Marrakech, for a green and engaged experience.

November 7th - 18th, 2016

A booth at COP22's **Green Zone** (« Art and Culture" space) where will be presented a **Maskbook exhibition** as well as a program of activities.

A Maskbook exhibition will be set up at Cafe Clock for the duration of COP22.

And also:

November 10th: Art of Change 21 will launch its website **Caire Game**, a tool which allow individuals to reduce their CO2 emissions, **in Arabic**.

November 11th: The artist Hassan Hajjaj will be given carte blanche.

November 12th: Cafe Clock will host a big Maskbook workshop

November 15th: A live creation of radiant flux portraits with solar lamps by the

artist **Yann Toma**

Meet and Mint: Free entrance at Riad Yima in a joyful and relaxed atmosphere. Discover the artwork of Hassan Hajjaj, animations around Paleo-Energetic Fresco, CAiRE GAME wheel and Maskbook. Light refreshments of mint tea and Moroccan pastries will be served.

Green P_Arty: A festive celebration, rich in knowledge, with art performances, concerts, conferences and debates (themes: energy, alimentation, sustainable lifestyles, women pioneers, entrepreneurship...). Artists, entrepreneurs, leaders, are able to meet, exchange and inspire each other. Hassan Hajjaj and Yann Toma will both be given carte blanche for two special performances.



Artist, photographer and contemporary fashion designer, **Hassan Hajjaj** is one of Morocco's preeminent international artists. Born in 1961 in Larache, Morocco, he lives and works between London and Marrakech.

Hassan Hajjaj has a diverse portfolio that includes installation, performance, fashion, and furniture design. He promotes "upcycling" which is at the heart of his creations and he collaborates with local communities.

Hassan Hajjaj is exhibited all over the world. In 2016 alone: at the Taymour Grahne Gallery in New York, at the Third Line Art Gallery in Dubai, and at Colette in Paris...

IKALA BALAD_E: amazing experience of sustainable mobility in Marrakech

In partnership with Pikala Bikes, a foundation promoting the bicycle as a vital mode of transport, and with the CMEM, Art of Change 21 presents PIKALA BALAD_E, **thematic bike tours in Marrakech**.

PIKALA BALAD_E aims to promote sustainable mobility, urban lifestyle, social inclusion and upcycling through a guided tour of Marrakech's green, cultural and empowerment initiatives.



In a nutshell:

- 2 tours per day
- 1 hour to 2 hours trips
- 10 participants per tour
- Three thematics tours: Environment, Sustainable lifestyle and culture, Social








IN THE GREEN ZONE

Cafe Clock will host a **Maskbook exhibition from November 7th to 18th** and will organize a **big Maskbook workshop on November 12th**.

In partnership with the landscape gardener Livia Kolb, Cafe Clock will also create an **urban organic garden** on their roof.





ART OF CHANGE 21

he French association **Art of Change 21** is the first initiative in the world to bring together art, social entrepreneurship and the youth movement. With Olafur Eliasson and Tristan Lecomte as its patrons, Art of Change unites 21 artists, social entrepreneurs and young "green" leaders from 12 countries. Art of Change 21 promotes co-creativity and innovation. Founded in 2014 by Alice Audouin, French pioneer of the link between art and sustainable development, its main partners are the Schneider Electric Foundation and the United Nations Environment.

Art of Change 21 develops two actions at the international level: Maskbook and CAiRE GAME.

Maskbook is an artistic and citizen action on the link between health and climate, which uses the mask as a symbol. The Maskbook Project includes exhibitions, workshops, a mobile App and an international portrait gallery on maskbook.org. The maskbook.org website, launched in Autumn 2015, features more than 15000 masked portraits in three languages (French, English and Chinese) involving citizens from more than 30 countries.

CAIRE GAME is a fun and useful tool that enables citizens to act in favor of climate at an accessible level, by helping to save CO2. The game features more than 150 specific actions, all of these being easily completed in daily life, often amusing and sometimes surprising. They involve our everyday activities: home, transport, work, hobbies, consumption habits, etc. CAIRE GAME has successfully reached over 5000 carbon reduction actions.
